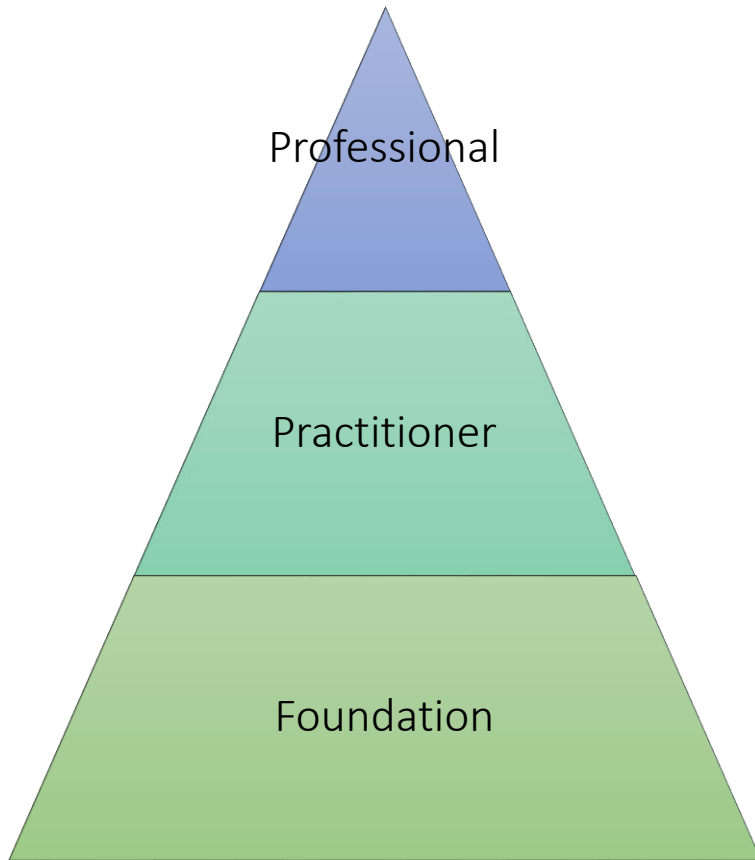

How to Write PRINCE2 Examinations?

Overview



- 2 ½ day residential Assessment Centre
- Group activities and exercises
- Based on a fictional project case study
- Assessment is against 19 individual performance criteria

- Objective testing format
- 8 questions per paper with 10 marks available per question
- 2.5 hours allowed
- Open book exam (manual only)
- 44 /80 marks (55%) required to pass

- Multiple choice format
- 75 questions per paper
- 5 questions to be trial and not counted in scores
- 35/70 marks (50%) required to pass
- Closed book

How to Write PRINCE2 Examinations?

Exam Type – PRINCE2 Foundation



- Exam Type: Online (web-based)
- Exam Format
 - 1 hour duration
 - Multiple choice format
 - 75 questions per paper
 - 5 questions to be trial and not counted in scores
 - 50%, i.e. 35 out of 70 marks are required to pass
 - Closed book
 - Notes are not allowed
 - No negative marking

Available Options

- Candidates may write PRINCE2 Foundation examinations at following locations.
 - Business Beam's Office
 - Any Prometric Center
 - Any Pearson VUE Center
 - Own home or office (using web proctor)

Section 2: Writing PRINCE2 Foundation Examination

Location: Business Beam Office



- Business Beam is an Accredited Training Organization (ATO). Candidates may write examination at Business Beam Office.
- The process is as follows:
 - Download 'Examination Registration Form' from www.businessbeam.com,
 - Fill-up the required information, including exam date, time, etc., and email the form at training@businessbeam.com,
 - Pay the examination fee (\$220) through cheque, cash or bank transfer,
 - Registers in the exam session using the exam session ID provided by Business Beam,
 - Ensure that the candidates have a laptop with latest version of IE, Chrome, Acrobat PDF reader and Flash plugin,
 - Visit Business Beam's office with your own the laptop, and write the exam.
 - Our authorized representative will proctor the examination.



Location: Prometric Centers

- PRINCE2 Foundation examination is available at Prometric centers - www.prometric.com
- Multiple Examination Institutes (EIs) offer this exam at Prometric centers.
- Only AXELOS develops the examination. Therefore the difficulty level is same across all EIs.
- Select any of the following EIs for examination:

Location: Pearson VUE Centers

- PRINCE2 Foundation examination is available at Pearson VUE centers – www.vue.com.

- Only AXELOS develops the examination. Therefore the difficulty level is same across all EIs.

Location: Own Home or Office

Writing PRINCE2 Practitioner Examinations

How to Write PRINCE2 Examinations?

Exam Type – PRINCE2 Practitioner



- Exam Type: Online (web-based)
- Exam Format
 - Objective testing
 - Two-and-a-half hours (150 minutes) duration, no additional reading time
 - 8 questions - 10 question items per question, each worth one mark
 - 55%, i.e. 44 out of 80 marks are required to pass
 - Open book exam (official PRINCE2 manual only).
 - Notes are not allowed
 - No negative marking

Available Options

- Candidates may write PRINCE2 Foundation examinations at following locations.
 - Business Beam's Office
 - Own home or office (using web proctor)
 - Any other ATO's premises

- Note: These exams are not available at Prometric or VUE centers.

Section 3: Writing PRINCE2 Practitioner Examination

Location: Business Beam Office



- Business Beam is an Accredited Training Organization (ATO). Candidates may write examination at Business Beam Office.
- The process is as follows:
 - Download 'Examination Registration Form' from www.businessbeam.com,
 - Fill-up the required information, including exam date, time, etc., and email the form at training@businessbeam.com,
 - Pay the examination fee (\$310) through cheque, cash or bank transfer,
 - Registers in the exam session using the exam session ID provided by Business Beam,
 - Ensure that the candidates have a laptop with latest version of IE, Chrome, Acrobat PDF reader and Flash plugin,
 - Visit Business Beam's office with your own the laptop, and write the exam.
 - Our authorized representative will proctor the examination.

Location: Own Home or Office

- Candidates can also write examination at their home, office or at any other convenient place.
- This exam is “Web Proctored”, i.e., proctor will watch-over the candidate through webcam.
- Candidates must have a desktop or laptop with webcam, microphone and speakers/headphone; very good and stable internet connection, and an interruption-free environment,
- It is expected that all candidates will carefully review and understand the respective policies and procedures of the Examination Institute (EI) in detail,
- Candidates MUST provide Business Beam’s training certificate to schedule examination,
